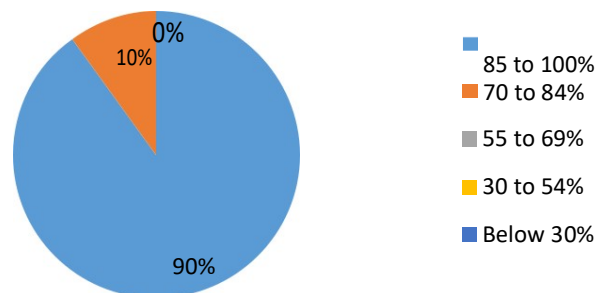

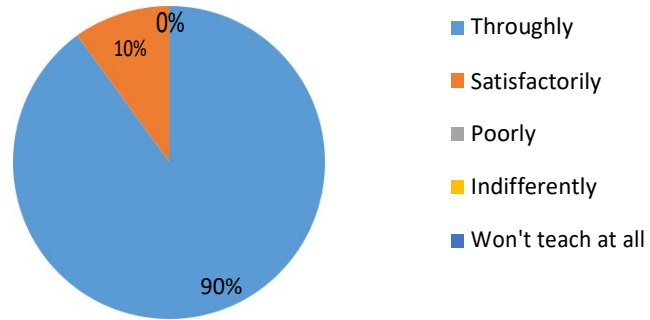

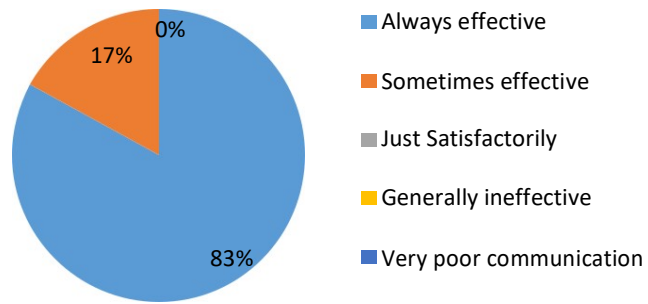
1. How much of syllabus was covered in the class?



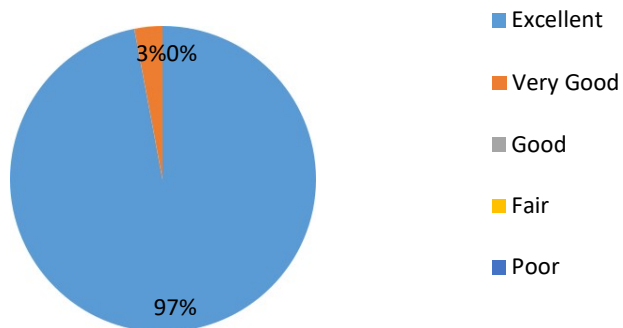
2. How Well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



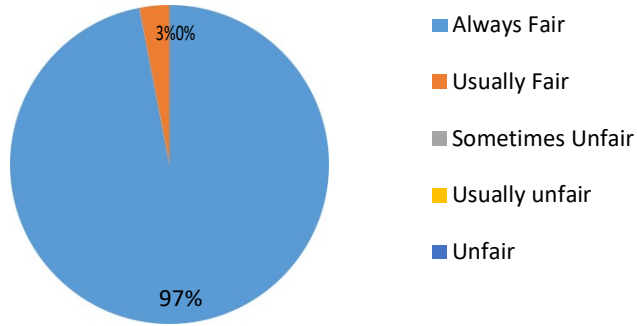

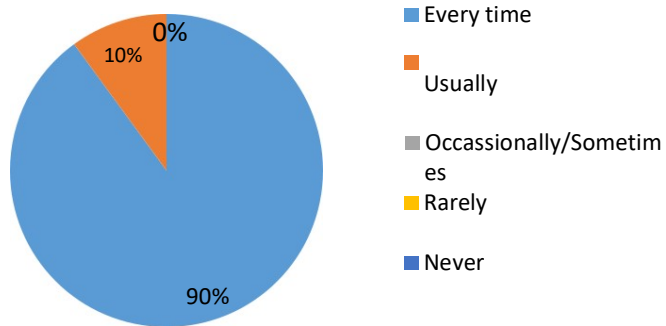

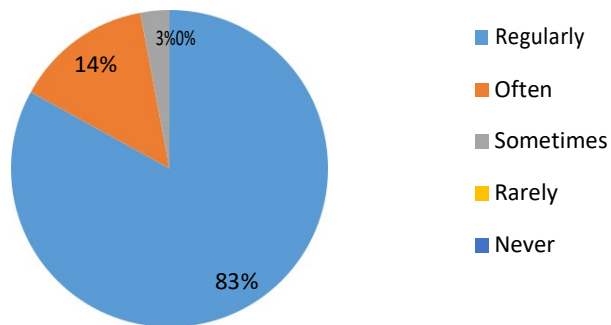
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers



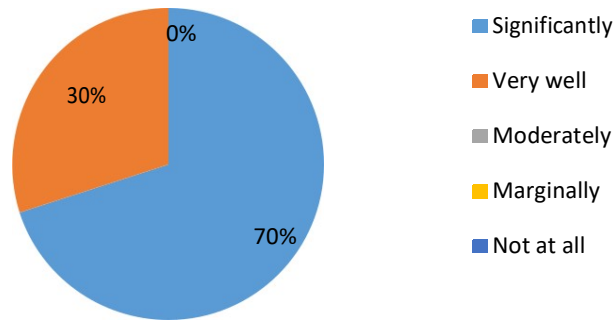

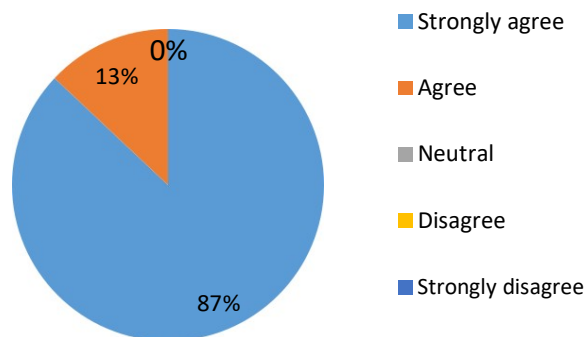

S.M.D. College conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching-Learning and evaluation to upgrade the quality as per the guidelines of NAAC. The data has been collected directly from the students through questionnaires. The outcome of the analysis as follow-

Out of the total respondents 90% of the students are of the view that 85% to 100% of the course is covered in the classes. Around 90% of the students agree that teachers are prepared thoroughly for the lectures. Out of total respondents 83% students agree that teachers are able to communicate effectively always, 3% of the students say that teacher's approach to teaching is very good and 97% of the respondents are of the view that teaching technique is excellent. Around 97% of students agree that there is always fairness in the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 90% students agree that teachers discuss their drawbacks with them. The mentoring process of the college is significantly as stated by the 90% of the

students. The 77% students agree that institution provide multiple opportunities learn and grow. The 87% of the respondents says that their teachers 'every time' in term about their expected competencies. Around 94% of the students agree that the teachers 'every time' illustrate the concept through examples. 74% of the respondents 'Fully' agree with that their teacher encourage them to face the challenges. To overcome for the weakness, 77% of students agree that their teachers 'every time' helps them. Maximum number of students 77% agrees that institution/teachers use student's centric methods such as participating learning for enhancing learning experiences. The 80% of the students agree that institution makes effects to encourage students in the mentoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. 87% of respondents agree that teachers encourage participating in extra- curricular activities. The 63% respondents stated that above 90% teachers used ICT tools while teaching, 19% students agree to 70% to 89%, 24% students says 50% to 69% teachers used these during their teaching.

In overall 87% of students strongly agree with the statement that the quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.
