"A trip to Environmental Awareness"  
 Place - Pari-Dihing Wild Life Sanctuary  
 Date - 08-08-2018

A field trip was organized by career counselling and guidance cell of S.M.D. College, Charing on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 on the theme "A trip to Environmental Awareness" to Pari-Dihing Wild Life Sanctuary (Pari-Dihing bird Sanctuary). The faculty members of the college undertook the field trip to Pari-Dihing Wild Life Sanctuary with 85 students of B.A. course. The trip was quite an interesting and exposure in connection with the course. Field visit is an integral part of education. The visit aims to expose the students to actual working conditions in nearby village of the bird sanctuary. The surrounding of the sanctuary was clean and neat and it was a plastic free zone. The trees around gives perfect house for the birds. The Pari-Dihing Wild Life Sanctuary has a rich wetland ecosystem. Many migratory birds come to the area each year. A number of wetlands, swamps, trees, grass, birds animals are found together in the area which form a rich bio-diversity. Pari-Dihing is situated 22 km distance from Sivasagar town. The students take a long walk and visit the villages. They collect data on living style, economic condition and prospect of tourism in the area. The students also noticed the degradation of environment

and less number of wild animals in nearby places of sanctuary. Excessive logging and high pressure on economic resources contributed to destruction of the wet lands.
